For the first time, the Company was independently owned and could make decisions that were best for the company and its clients and not just its shareholders. The 19-year-old "start-up" pumped up its sales and marketing efforts and invested in technology at a time when its competitors were sitting idle. The following year, 1031 CORP. acquired two competitors; one in Media, PA and the other in Westminster, MD. Their boldest move came in 2014 when 1031 CORP. acquired another competitor - in Bend, Oregon. That Pacific Northwest operation now has a team of three and the Collegeville office has grown to twelve.

McDonnell is a member of the Counselors of Real Estate (CRE) and a Certified Exchange Specialist[®] (CES[®]). She has been involved in thousands of exchange transac-
