Phoenixville Restaurants, Breweries & Retail Shops Open Outdoors on Weekends

During the Yellow Phase in Chester County the Phoenixville Borough Council voted to approve road closures. This allows for the downtown restaurants, bars, businesses, retailers, art studios and boutiques on Bridge Street to extend outside of their shops onto the sidewalk and the street.

This concept will create a pedestrian walkway in the center of the road for patrons to maintain a safe social distance.

Businesses will be permitted to set up in the closed sidewalk and roadway for the following hours: Thursdays: 4pm – 10pm, Friday through Sunday: 7am – 10pm

Patrons coming to the downtown must wear a mask unless seated at a table, or unless the patron is medically unable to wear one.

We strongly encourage that you leave pets at home when choosing to dine downtown to keep the pedestrian right of way clear.

No Parking - 100 and 200 block of Bridge Street from 2pm Thursday through 7am Monday

Roads Closed - 100 and 200 blocks of Bridge Street from 3pm Thursday through 7am Monday. The Main and Bridge Street parking lot will also be closed for the duration of the road closure.

Main Street and Gay Street will remain open. North Main Street will remain closed at the railroad trestle construction area until that project is completed.
