COMMUNITY TOGETHERNESS CREATES GREAT PLACE TO LIVE

Travel + Leisure Magazine recently named Phoenixville as the #1 Best Small Town to live in the U.S. One of the attributes of Phoenixville is our community. "100 Men of Phoenixville" embodies the community spirit by coming together to raise money and awareness for local charities. Money raised locally and given back locally. Each member contributes \$100 that is given to three local charities. Phoenixville has two hundred forty recognized non-profits. At the event of "100 Men of Phoenixville" on October 15, 2025, at the Phoenixville's VFW, three charities were awarded a portion of the money raised. Each local charity presented their services to the community and the needs of their organization. Afterwards members in attendance voted for one of the three. Typically, the charity with the most votes would receive 70 percent of the money raised at the event, the second most votes would receive 20 percent, and the ten percent balance going to the final charity. There was a tie vote for first place so the top two money awards will be equally split between the two top charities. There was \$12,600 raised and thus \$5,670 will be going to Phoenixville Senior Center and Health Care Access Phoenixville while Satori Dojo will receive \$1,260 of the donations. With this \$12,600 raised for the second event and a total of \$14,200 of the inaugural event for a total of \$26,800 for the initial year of operations. More than just the money, the connections and networking of community minded individuals coming together to share ideas and help each other and the community at large is what "100 Men of Phoenixville" is organized to do. Good Samaritan Services, St. Nick's Handyman Services, and First United Methodist Church of Phoenixville being the three awarded charities from the inaugural event of April 2, 2025,each presented at the second event how they put the gifted funds to work in the community. The "100 Men of Phoenixville" group is organized and run by nine members of the community.
