As the year closes, the TriCounty Area Chamber of Commerce would like to urge you to recognize the direct economic impact of your holiday spending decisions. Choosing local for holiday shopping, dining, and services

is not just a seasonal tradition, it is an investment in the health and stability of Pottstown, Boyertown, and the surrounding areas.

The foundation of a thriving community is the cumulative impact of its resident's financial choices. Our goal is to curate an environment where local businesses, the primary job creators in our region, can flourish. This commitment is supported by clear data. Economic studies confirm the profound multiplier effect of buying local. Data often replicated across various communities, consistently demonstrates that for every \$100 spent at local independent businesses, approximately \$68 remains in the local economy, while the same \$100 spent at a national chain typically retains only \$43 locally.

This 60% higher retention rate translates directly into tangible benefits for TriCounty:

• Job Creation: Higher local revenue supports increased staffing and wages at our independent establishments.

- Tax Base Growth: Local profits generate greater sales tax and property tax revenue, funding essential community services like schools and infrastructure.
- Local Interdependence: Local businesses are significantly more likely to utilize other local services (e.g., local accounting, printing, and maintenance firms), creating a robust, interconnected ecosystem of trade)

Local businesses, including our members like Dani Bee Funky and Carmelo's Pizza and Italian Iace, are more than retailers; they are community stakeholders. These often family-owned establishments are the primary sponsors of local sports leagues, the first to donate to school fundraisers, and the key financial participants in community events,a level of local contribution larger corporations often do not match.



This holiday season, the Chamber asks every resident to treat their purchases as an economic vote. Whether you are finding gifts at a TriCounty Chamber member store, booking a reservation at one of our independent restaurants, or contracting the services of a local professional, your choice directly amplifies our regional economic strength.
