Adding loading docks to your facility expands shipping and receiving capabilities

to keep business moving quickly and meet essential goals and deadlines.

Different types of loading docks are available to suit your environment.

Flush Dock – allows for the back of the loading truck to be flush against the building.

Open Dock – an open platform which may include a canopy but is open to the elements.

Saw Tooth Dock – shaped at an angle and can easily fit into narrow spaces.

Enclosed Dock – allows trucks to park indoors to protect valuable goods.
