Pottstown Dance Theatre Will Return to the Olympic Games

The Pottstown Dance Theatre, the ONLY school in the region that was invited to and performed in London during the 2012 Olympic Games, will return to the Games in Tokyo for 2020. The dancers are excited but are not waiting around for this event in order to perform on a world stage. Members of the Repertory Ensemble will be performing at Carnegie Hall in New York City in January of 2018. The school works year round to keep dancers performing and at their best levels both technically and artistically.

The school was founded in 1964 by Phyllis Dersh Rudzitis. In 2001, international dance artist Michelle Jones Wurtz became the new director. Since then, she has taken students to the international dance festival in Poland, to Lincoln Center in New York, to Carnegie Hall in New York, and most notably to London during the 2012 Olympic Games. Dancers are encouraged to become artists in their own right and have many performing opportunities locally and on international stages. Students learn an art form while developing friendships that often last a lifetime.

The school is currently accepting registrations for their summer classes and camps. Beginning June 17, there will be a weekly morning ballet class from 10:30-12 followed by pointe technique from 12-12:45 for various levels. 


