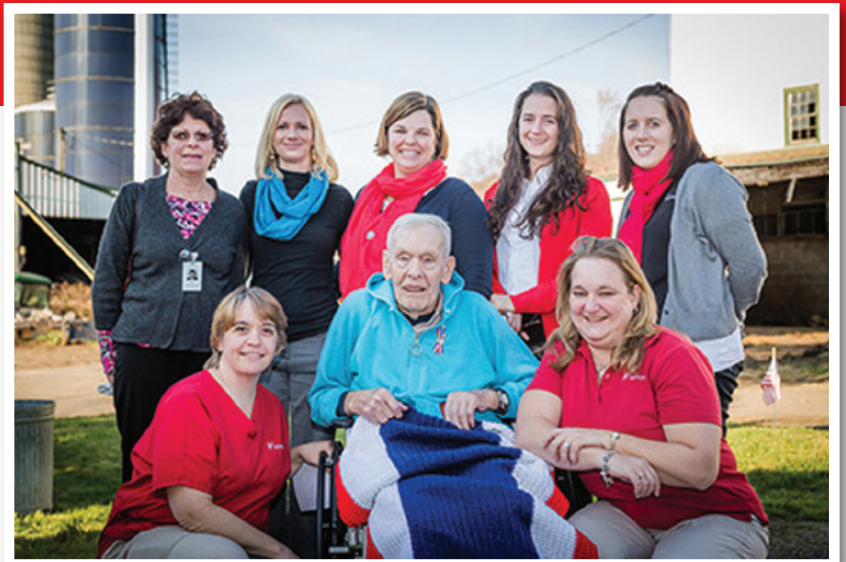
A Tribute to Our Dedicated Interdisciplinary Team

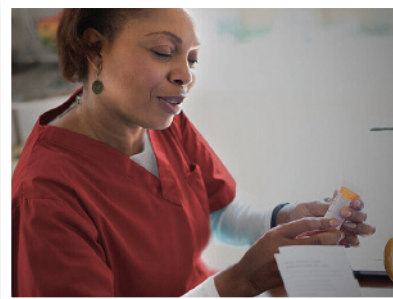
