MAKING YOUR SMALL BUSINESS WEBSITE MOBILE FRIENDLY

Today, having a mobile-friendly website for your business is non-negotiable. That's because back in 2015, Google changed the game and started prioritizing mobile-friendly websites in its organic search results page rankings. Since then, the need for a mobile-friendly site has only continued to climb.

It's Google's world and we have to play in it.

An astounding 87-percent of all web searches take place on Google's platform. With this level of market share, it's no surprise that Google is setting the standards and rules for how the world does business online.

Today, years after Google's shift to prioritize mobile-friendly sites in search results, nearly 60-percent of all web searches take place on a mobile device. So, what does this all mean?

It means that if your business website is not mobile-friendly, then you're losing business.

Responsive design is a design solution that accounts for how the site will respond to your content and graphics at various pixel widths and heights. The width of a mobile device is far less than a desktop, and your website needs to account for both.

A website designer will create a site using responsive design and assess the way the site responds to text and images of different sizes throughout the design process.


